HK International schools

1. How to prep your kids for the entrance exam?

- **a.** Identify the necessary exam, obtain test prep materials, take mock-up tests, identify areas of weakness and drill those areas.
- b. What are my weak areas? How do I create a study plan to improve these areas? I never learned these topics in class, how can I teach myself this material? These can be difficult tasks for a student and so this is often when students will look for help. A little bit of guidance and regimented study plan from an experienced exam tutor goes a long way and sets students apart from the rest of the pack.

2. What are some tips for a successful video interview?

- a. By far the most important element of an interview is how well prepared you are. How much do you know about the school? Can you explain why you think you are a good fit for this school? Do you know what sets them apart? This is one key question many schools will ask; your answer may be the deciding factor on whether you get in.
- b. How should the student act?

i. A few common issues we see: Be polite yet confident, make good eye contact, speak audibly and clearly, minimize use of "like" and "um", answer in complete sentences.

- **a.** Tell your child to listen carefully to the teacher's instructions. Follow all directions.
- **b.** Prepare for group games during the interview.
- C. The school will provide puzzles and lego for kids to play and ask the teacher to interact with them to test their reactions.
- **d.** Parents themselves must be prepared for the interview too.

5. Is a bilingual stream a better choice?

- **a.** Do you want to give your child an opportunity to learn a second language at an early age? Are you looking for a bilingual education that goes above and beyond the weekly language class taught at most international schools? Whether it's a "Shì, Yes or Oui" the answer could be a fully-immersive bilingual programme offered at just a handful of international kindergartens and pre-schools in Hong Kong.
- **b.** The benefits of children learning two languages simultaneously are supported by research and has been found to stimulate the brain cells and sharpen the mind. It generally takes around five years to be proficient in a second language so by putting your pre-schooler into a bilingual curriculum you are giving them the best head start. Also students are exposed to a new culture as well as a new language which encourages them to embrace diversity.
- **c.** In terms of cons, a bilingual programme can be more expensive as bilingual schools will hire additional teachers and this cost can be reflected in the tuition fee. In addition, the workload for learning two languages can be heavy and some students may struggle. Finally, parents need to invest their own time and effort into a bilingual programme and support their child with learning the second language at home which can be challenging if parents do not speak the language.
- **d.** Questions to ask. Consider these points when making your decision:
 - i. Are you planning to stay in Hong Kong? Bilingual education works best if you pursue it for at least two or three years.
 - ii. What language courses are offered by the school once the bilingual programme ends, typically at the start of secondary?
 - iii. Are the teachers in the bilingual programme a native speaker? For an authentic immersion experience, students need to be taught by a native speaker.
 - iv. How much of the secondary language is taught in the classroom? Some programmes use both languages equally, while others may teach 25% in English, 75% in Mandarin for example.
 - v. How are students assessed? Students can sit external exams such as the HSK Centre's Youth Chinese Test (YCT) and the ACTFL Assessment of Performance toward Proficiency in Languages (AAPPL).
 - vi. What teaching tactics are used to overcome language barriers, encourage understanding, and reduce frustration? For example, the teacher can physically act out what they are trying to teach.
 - vii. Does the school have dedicated bilingual classrooms? You should be looking for classrooms that represent both languages word walls, books, student work etc and have class items clearly labelled in both languages.
 - viii. Does the school library stock books and resources in the target language?

6.If my child goes to an international school, is it hard to join a local stream?

a. For most local schools the language of instruction is Chinese. Some subjects like Mathematics will only be taught in Chinese by most schools. To understand the subjects, your child must understand Chinese.

- **b.** Local school interviews using both Chinese and English, some expat children might find it's difficult to adapt into an Chinese speaking only environment in a short period of time.
- **c.** Local schools are known for their structured approach to learning. However, not every student is best suited to this highly rigid learning style.
- d. There are 3 types of schools in the 'Local' School System:
 - i. Government schools which are run by the government itself or by charitable organisations the latter being described as 'aided' schools (pictured above). Education is free in these schools from Primary One to Secondary Three with the government subsidising fees in Secondary Four and Five. These establishments follow a curriculum set by the Education Bureau (EB) and children sit local Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) exams in secondary school. There are both Chinese-medium instruction (CMI) and a few English-medium instruction (EMI) schools.
 - ii. Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) schools which are subsidised by the government and are allowed to charge fees. These additional fees range from a modest \$3000 to \$90000 per annum the latter of which is the reported fee for more prestigious schools such as Diocesan Boys School. Within government guidelines and with the approval of the EB DSS schools can set their own admission criteria and have some flexibility in the curriculum they follow, sometimes offering overseas examinations such as IGCSE or International Baccalaureat (IB).
 - iii. Private 'local' schools which usually charge less than international schools though not in all cases. These schools have their own admission systems and within guidelines set by the EB follow a curriculum of their choice. Many do IB and IGCSE.

7. Which international School in HK requires an Entrance Exam; if so, which exam?

When applying to international schools in HK, they often require an entrance examination. This exam can make or break your chances for acceptance; a little bit of prep goes a long way. 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8. What is the CAT 4 exam?

- **a.** The Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) is a diagnostic assessment that is designed to help students and their teachers understand how they learn and what their academic potential might be. It assesses how students think in areas that are known to make a difference to learning.
- **b.** While many tests focus on a child's attainment in core subjects, CAT4 is designed to give schools a much broader, more rounded view of each child, their potential and how they learn. Results help teachers decide about the pace of learning that is right for a student and whether additional support or challenge is needed.
- **C.** Tasks involve thinking about shapes and patterns (Non-Verbal Reasoning), words (Verbal Reasoning), numbers (Quantitative Reasoning) and some questions are answered by mentally generating and transforming visual images (Spatial Ability).
- **d.** It is a well-known assessment in schools; teachers value its ability to provide an understanding of what a child is capable of rather than defining them by their understanding of a body of knowledge in particular subjects

9. What is "The Independent School Entrance Examination"?

The Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE) is an entrance exam used by many independent schools and magnet schools in the United States.

The ISEE has four levels:

- a. Primary level, for entrance to grades 2-4;
- **b**. Lower level, for entrance in grades 5-6;
- C. Middle level, for entrance in grades 7-8;
- **d.** Upper level, for entrance in grades 9-12.

All levels consist of five sections: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics Achievement, and a 30-minute essay.

HK local schools

1. If my child goes to a local school, is it hard to move from the local system to an international school?

Children sometimes start in the local stream and then later move to an international school. This can be challenging but never impossible.

- **a.** The most common challenge for students transitioning from local schools to international schools is the English-language requirement.
- **b.** Students who struggle with English are usually placed into an English second language (ESL) stream. Their difficulty understanding and applying English may result in struggling with other subjects too such as science or maths.

- **C.** However this is not the end of the world. By being more prepared in terms of English language before entering an international school students have a faster rate of progress/success.
- **d.** The benefit to being in this international system is not only the exposure to English language but the immersion in the culture. Children are able to make friends across several countries developing not only their academic English but their playground and conversational English as well.
- e. With English being taught as a foreign language local schools tend to promote rote learning of the language. This results in students having a strong grasp of grammar but limited knowledge of how to express themselves naturally. Universities commonly look for applicants who can add value to their university and much of the time this is displayed in character self-awareness and mindset.
- 2. My partner and I are not from Hong Kong, but we would like to enrol our child in a localkindergarten. What do we need to know?
 - a. Your child must have an HK ID card.
 - **b.** Local schools teach most classes in Cantonese. As part of their entrance exam, all local schools in HK will require a chinese proficiency test, meaning that a solid foundation of Chinese will be necessary to be admitted, even at the Kindergarten level.
